- I. Purpose: This policy has been established to provide incentives for NTNU full-time instructors and researchers to engage in beneficial interactions and collaborations with industry participants, thereby broadening the applicability of NTNU's research efforts to contribute towards industry development.
- II. The academia-industry cooperation (the "Cooperative Project") rewarded under this policy shall refer to any project executed by an NTNU full-time instructor or researcher using NTNU's name in association with a natural person, a government agency, a civil organization (corporation, foundation), a state-owned enterprise or a private enterprise (the private enterprise must have been incorporated and registered in accordance with local or foreign regulations), for which the rights and obligations are outlined in an agreement created according to NTNU's Academia-Industry Cooperation Policy.  
Where a Cooperative Project involves a government agency, when calculating eligibility for rewards, rewards are given only if the project receives monetary contributions from a state-owned or private enterprise. In the above situation, the amount of reward is calculated only based on contributions made by state-owned and private enterprises.  
Budgets that span multiple years shall be handled in accordance with the Higher Education Database Indicator Manual.  
Cooperative Projects that are exempted from remaining administrative management fees shall no longer be eligible to apply for further rewards under this policy.  
For applicants who have been granted this reward, all Cooperative Projects, technology/copyright licensing and royalties achieved before the year rewarded shall no longer be eligible to apply for further rewards under this policy, whether or not such achievements have been taken into consideration during the conferment of the previous reward.

III. Rewarded candidates:

(I) Candidates who satisfy any of the following criteria may apply for the Academia-industry Cooperation Excellence Reward :

- (1) A full-time instructor or researcher of NTNU who has signed a Cooperative Project with a total budget reaching NT\$800,000 and above (inclusive) and was charged administrative management fees reaching NT\$80,000 and above (inclusive) in the previous one year in NTNU's name according to internal procedures, and having completed the project as the principal investigator (calculation be based on the year in which the project ended).
- (2) A full-time instructor or researcher of NTNU who has signed Cooperative Projects with a total budget reaching NT\$1,200,000 or above (inclusive) and was charged administrative management fees reaching NT\$120,000 or above (inclusive) since 2011 to the year before application in NTNU's name according to administrative procedures, and having completed the project as the principal investigator (calculation be based on the year in which the project ended).

(II) Candidates who satisfy any of the following criteria may apply for the R&D Results Achievement Promotion Excellence Reward:

- (1) A full-time instructor or researcher of NTNU who has arranged technology transfer or copyright licensing in the previous one year in NTNU's name according to internal procedures and has generated more than NT\$300,000 (inclusive) in licensing fees and royalties.
- (2) A full-time instructor or researcher of NTNU who has arranged technology transfer/copyright licensing agreements and generated NT\$500,000 or more (inclusive) worth of licensing fees/royalties since 2011 up until one year before the application in NTNU's name according to administrative procedures.
- (3) A full-time instructor or researcher of NTNU who establishes a spin-off in accordance with the National Taiwan Normal University Regulations for R&D Result Spin-offs, and licensing fees/royalties distributed to NTNU reaches NT\$500,000 or more (inclusive).

IV. Rewards:

Instructors and researchers who satisfy the criteria in Article 3, Paragraph 1 are entitled to a reward of 20% of administrative management fees from the award winning project (limited to NT\$100,000) and a commendation certificate.

All instructors and researchers who satisfy of the criteria listed in Article 3, Paragraph

2 are entitled to a reward of NT\$30,000 and a commendation certificate.

- V. Source of funds: This reward shall be funded by NTNU under the account - Academic Research Promotion.
- VI. This reward may be applied for between March 1 and March 31 each year. To apply, the applicant needs to submit an application form (see Attachment) and furnish photocopies of relevant agreements to the Division of Research and Industry Liaison, Office of Research and Development.
- VII. This Policy has been passed with resolutions sought from an Academic Meeting, and is implemented with the approval of the President.
