


Steps for FWCI (Field-Weighted Citation Impact) Inquiry

Step.1

§ Visit <http://www.scopus.com/> from the school domain. To search for teacher's journal papers, it is suggested to search through "Authors". Click the name of the teacher to view papers published over the years.
