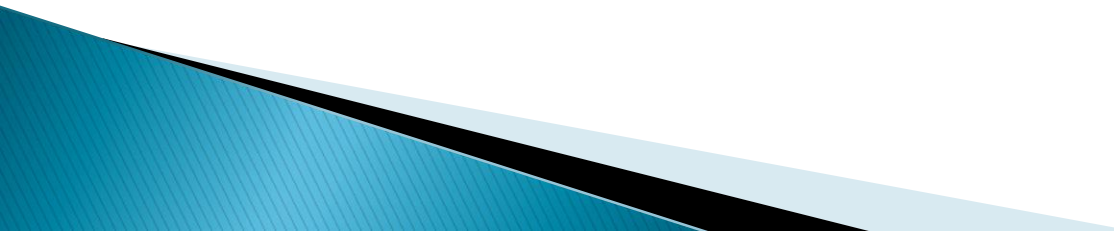

Academic Publishing

- ▶ **Why do we write and publish papers?**

The purposes of an academic paper

- ▶ **To honestly describe the issues you are concerned in your papers, the approach you adopted for collecting data, and what you found**
 - ▶ **To shorten the gap between the known and the unknown of the knowledge pool**
 - ▶ **To provide the audience with useful experiences for conducting their research or solving their problems.**
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Who will be your audience?



- ▶ **The purpose of a dialogue**
 - **Daily conversation among friends**
 - **Statements in a classroom**
 - **Facebook friends or blog readers**
 - **Academic writing**
- ▶ **Audience**
 - **Unfamiliar vs. Familiar**
 - **Determined or not**
 - **Academic peers or not**

The tone of your paper

- ▶ **Precisely express the RQs and describe how the research procedure went and how the data were collected, followed by appropriate data analysis and objective explanation of the results. Finally, conclude the paper with both faithful evaluation of contribution and suggestions for future research.**

Write an academic paper: storytelling

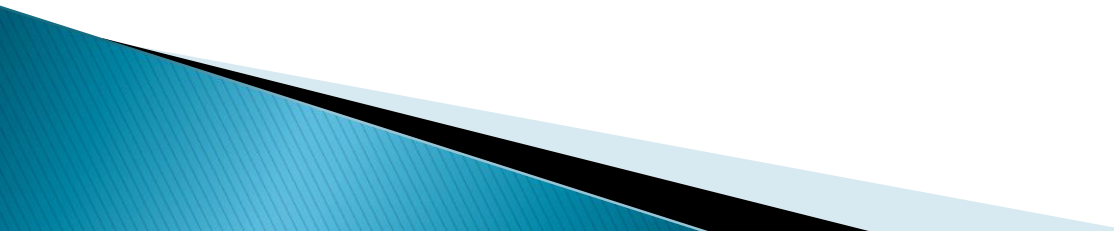
- ▶ **Purposes ?**

- ▶ **Expectation ? Audience's vs. teller's**




Submission

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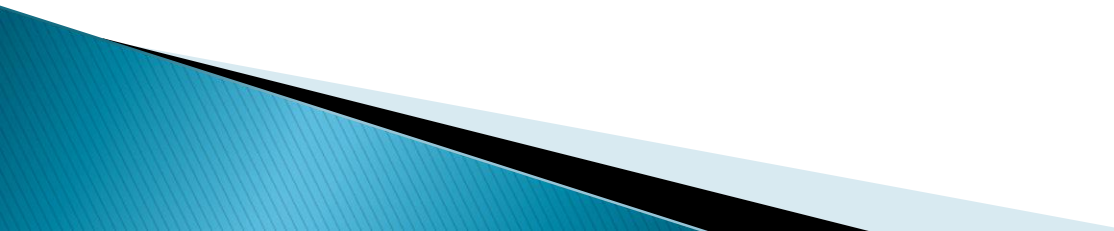
